Memo 1658: Nomination for Master Electricians Member Director

1. Formal nominations are now invited for the position of Member Director in accordance with Rules 7.3 and 7.4. Director Omri Ash is retiring by rotation and is eligible to stand for re-election for a further term of three years.
2. Before submitting a nomination to National Office, it must be endorsed by one Branch Committee and seconded by another Branch Committee, in accordance with Rule 7.3.1.4.

To nominate, candidates must:

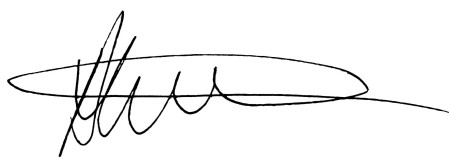
- Be a member of the Association in accordance with Rule 7.3.1(b).
- Complete the **Nomination Form**.
- Complete the **Board Director Capability Self-Assessment**.
- Submit both documents to the Appointments Advisory Committee via board@masterelectricians.org.nz.

Nominations close at **5.00 pm on Friday, 21 August 2026**.

3. Interviews with eligible candidates will be conducted online by the Appointments Advisory Committee between **31 August and 3 September 2026**.
4. Following the interview process, all eligible candidate nominations will be forwarded to Branches and be published on the Master Electricians website by **Friday, 4 September 2026**.
5. Branch Committees will be asked to vote for their preferred candidate. Voting closes on **Friday, 18 September 2026 at 5.00 pm**. Each Branch Committee shall have one vote, and voting will be conducted in accordance with the Rules.

6. The successful candidate will be determined by majority vote and announced no later than **2 October 2026**.

8. The Board is committed to appointing the best available candidates to meet its governance needs. As such, multiple nominations from the same Branch are welcome where appropriate.
