Branch Presidents, Secretaries, and all members of Master Electricians.

Memo 1659: Nomination for Master Electricians Member Director

- Formal nominations are now invited for the position of Member Director in accordance with Rules 7.3 and 7.4 of the constitution. Director Omri Ash (Chair) is retiring by rotation and has opted not to stand for re-election for a further term of three years. The Board has elected current Member-Elected Director Shaun Dent as the new Chair of Master Electricians, effective immediately, creating one vacancy for a new Member Director.
- Before submitting a nomination to National Office, it must be endorsed by one Branch Committee and seconded by another Branch Committee, in accordance with Rule 7.3.1.4.

To nominate, candidates must:

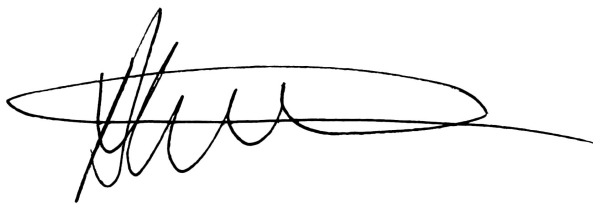
- Be a member of the Association in accordance with Rule 7.3.1(b).
- Complete the [Nomination Form](#).
- Complete the [Board Director Capability Self-Assessment](#).
- Submit both documents to the Appointments Advisory Committee via board@masterelectricians.org.nz.

Nominations open on 31 August and close at 5pm on 30 September 2026.

- Interviews with eligible candidates will be conducted online by the Appointments Advisory Committee between **5 and 9 October 2026**.
- Following the interview process, all eligible candidate nominations will be forwarded to Branch Committees on **12 October 2026**.
- Branch Committees will be asked to vote for their preferred candidate. Voting closes at **5pm on 23 October**. Each Branch Committee shall have one vote, and voting will be conducted in accordance with the Rules.
- The successful candidate will be determined by majority vote and announced to branches and members on **9 November 2026**. The new Member Director will attend their first Board meeting on 2 December.
